1. Jamestown was founded in 1607.

3. The charter gave the Virginia Company of London the right to establish settlement in North America.
4. One hardship faced by the settlers/early colonists is that they were starving due to lacking basic building and farming skills.
5. Jamestown was originally a peninsula bordered on three sides by the James River.
6. It was important for the Jamestown settlement to be near deep water because boats traveling with goods to and from Europe needed deep water to dock.

7. Powhatan was a chief of many tribes that helped teach the colonists survival skills.
